Outdoor Irrigation and Cleaning Procedures

## Project Location:

Turner Field, Atlanta Ga.

Baseball stadiums are one of the largest consumers of water because of their high upkeep of field and turf conditions and the amount of impervious surfaces both on the inside and outside of the park. Thus it was a dually positive partnership when ECOVIE teamed up with the Atlanta Braves to bring the first ever Rainwater Collection System to a professional sports park in Atlanta. The 1,500 gallon Rainwater Collection System on the right side of Turner Field's entrance can supply the Braves with up to 20,000 gallons of water over an entire season.

During the 2011 Braves campaign, approx.. 10,000 gallons of water were utilized to help irrigate plants and extensively clean the outfield plaza. The Atlanta Braves hope to capture even more this season!
